WHAT IS CARBON MONOXIDE

Carbon monoxide (CO) is a colourless, odourless and tasteless toxic gas that interferes with the blood's ability to absorb and transport oxygen. It is produced when fuels are burned incompletely; tobacco smoking, idling gasoline-powered

- vehicles and the burning of oil, coal, wood, charcoal, kerosene, propane or natural gas can all produce carbon monoxide.
- -The first line of defense against carbon monoxide poisoning is prevention through annual inspections of your home heating equipment, including vents and chimneys.
- -Alarms are a good second line of defense and every home should have one or more. Carbon Monoxide detectors normally expire in 5 to 7 years and should be installed as per manufacturer's recommendations.
